Our 2017 Accomplishments

The year 2017 was a phenomenal beginning for Primary Care Haiti. Haiti's healthcare system is lacking in primary care and emergency medicine. Cervical cancer, which is preventable, is still the number one cause of cancer in Haitian women. There is no coordinated Haitian emergency medical system. Our organization is focused on educating Haitian physicians, nurses, and other medical professionals on the skills necessary to prevent disease and respond to emergencies around the country. Thanks to your donations, we accomplished the following:

June 12-17, 2017 Medical Training Trip to Pignon, Haiti:

- ACLS (Advanced Cardiac Life support) training for nurses and doctors
- BLS (Basic Life Support) training for nurses and doctors
- Cervical cancer screening training for Haitian nurses and doctors (including PAP smear and mobile colposcopy training)
- Over 600 patients screened for cervical cancer
- Thousands of dollars worth of equipment donated and shipped at no cost courtesy of DHL

- Donated equipment used to set up an ICU, NICU, and emergency room at L'hôpital Bienfaisance Pignon, in rural Haiti
- Electronic Medical Record setup and training, made possible thanks to donated computers from South Florida Digital Alliance
- Training provided in all aspects of patient triage, taking vital signs, and keeping accurate medical records
- Community education training on breast cancer and cervical cancer prevention, early detection, and treatment

The day after our first ACLS (advanced cardiac life support) in June, at L'Hôpital Bienfaisance, a gentleman was brought into the ER after he was involved in a motor vehicle accident. According to the physician who was on the scene, the patient's heart had stopped; but thanks to the training he had received

the previous day, he was able to bring him back to life."


